Assuming continued employment, all RSUs held by the Reporting Person will vest and be paid out as follows: 15,337 on October 31, 2016; 15,078 on October 31, 2017; 10,181 on October 31, 2018; and 21,615 on October 31, 2019. Upon payout, shares will be withheld to cover minimum statutory tax obligations. RSUs are accompanied by dividend equivalent rights that will be payable in cash at the time of payout of the related shares.
