ITEM 8.01. OTHER EVENTS

On October 1, 2004 the Company issued a press release titled "TEXAS REGULATORY AGENCY PROPOSES AGREED ORDER FOR AMERICAN ECOLOGY'S TEXAS SUBSIDIARY" disclosing that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") has proposed an agreed order which includes an administrative penalty of \$138,320.
