China Yuchai International Limited ( CYI ) subsidiary, Guangxi Yuchai Machinery Company Limited ( Yuchai ), has agreed to extend the maturity date of the Rmb 205 million loans due to Yuchai from Yuchai Marketing Co., Ltd ( YMCL ) from the previous maturity date of June 1, 2007 to a new maturity date of May 30, 2008. YMCL is wholly-owned by Coomber Investments Limited ( Coomber ), a shareholder of CYI, and Guangxi Yuchai Machinery Group Company Limited (the State Holding Company ), a shareholder of Yuchai. The loans bear interest at the rate of 6.57% per annum. The loans are secured by guarantees from Coomber and the State Holding Company.
