(1) On 06/03/2011, Reporting Person was awarded a number of performance-based restricted stock units (RSUs), within a preset range, with the actual number contingent upon the achievement of certain performance criterion. If certain performance criterion is achieved, fifty percent (50%) of the grant vests on the third and fourth anniversaries of the date of grant, subject to applicable taxes upon delivery.

(2) Includes disposition of shares exempt under Rule 16b-3 as payment of tax liability to Company incident to vesting of restricted stock share award.

(3) Price reflects weighted average sales price; actual sales prices ranged from \$10.335 to \$10.64. The reporting person undertakes to provide, upon request by the Commission staff, the Issuer, or a security holder of the Issuer, full information regarding the number of shares purchased or sold at each separate price.
