

Item 1.01 Conflict Minerals Disclosure and Report

AeroGrow International, Inc. has determined that tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold, collectively "Conflict Minerals," are necessary to the functionality or production of its products. In 2017, AeroGrow International, Inc. contracted for the manufacture of products containing Conflict Minerals but did not directly manufacture products containing Conflict Minerals.

Conflict Minerals Disclosure

We undertook due diligence measures, including surveying our direct suppliers via an industry-standard survey template for conflict minerals, to try to determine the sources of these minerals, which we purchase through a complex supply chain.

Currently, we do not have sufficient information from our suppliers or other sources to determine the country of origin of the conflict minerals used in our products or identify the facilities used to process those conflict minerals. Therefore, we cannot exclude the possibility that some of these conflict minerals may have originated in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or an adjoining country and are not from recycled or scrap sources. However, we believe we have exercised the due diligence efforts necessary to understand our supply chain.
