#### ITEM 12. RESULTS OF OPERATIONS AND FINANCIAL CONDITION

On April 21, 2004, DSP Group, Inc. (the Company) announced its financial results for the quarter ended March 31, 2004. A copy of this press release, dated April 21, 2004, is attached and filed herewith as Exhibit 99.1, and is incorporated herein by reference.

In addition to the disclosure of financial results for the first quarter of 2004 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in the United States (GAAP), the press release also disclosed pro forma net income and diluted earnings per share (EPS) figures, which are considered non-GAAP financial measures. Generally, a non-GAAP financial measure is a numerical measure of a company s performance, financial position or cash flows that either excludes or includes amounts that are not normally excluded or included in the most directly comparable measure calculated and presented in accordance with GAAP. The proforma net income and diluted EPS figures disclosed in the press release excluded a capital gain of \$20,827,000 resulting from the sale of two million shares of the AudioCodes Ltd stock and a capital gain of \$490,000 resulting from the sale of all of the Company s holdings in the Tomen Corporation stock, as well as taxes relating to the sales in the aggregate amount of \$8,517,000. The Company believes that this proforma presentation of net income and diluted EPS is useful to investors in comparing results for the quarter ended March 31, 2004 to the same period during 2003, because it excludes items that management does not consider meaningful for purposes of analyzing the Company s operating results and budget-planning decisions. In addition, the Company has historically reported similar proforma financial measures to its investors and believes that the inclusion of comparative numbers provides consistency in the Company s financial reporting.
