Korea Electric Power Corporation ( KEPCO ) has decided to temporarily suspend the underground transmission line construction project starting from January 1, 2009. The project involves replacing above-the-ground transmission lines with underground transmission lines; underground construction involves greater capital expenditure. The suspension of this project is part of cost-saving measures being undertaken by KEPCO in the face of the expected decrease in profitability of KEPCO in 2008 primarily as a result of the increase in fuel prices and Won depreciation.
