Item 7.01 Regulation FD.

As Trans Energy, Inc. (the Company) has previously reported, on September 28 and December 17, 2012, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued to the Company seven administrative compliance orders and a request for information (the CWA Matter). The orders and request relate to our compliance with Clean Water Act (CWA) permitting requirements at seven pond and/or well site locations in Marshall and Wetzel Counties, West Virginia and concern the alleged discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States.

On August 25, 2014, we entered into a civil Consent Decree with the EPA with respect to the CWA Matter and related issues that were discovered based upon an internal audit that we conducted. A copy of the EPA's press release regarding this Consent Decree is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1.

1. The Consent Decree requires us to pay a \$3,000,000 civil penalty in two installments.
2. The Consent Decree requires us to perform certain restoration activities at the affected pond, well pad and access road sites over a period of three construction seasons. The EPA has estimated that the restoration could cost as much as \$13 million.

3. The Consent Decree also requires to put in place and maintain an environmental compliance program. On August 29, 2014, the EPA filed information in the federal district court in the Northern District of West Virginia alleging that Trans Energy had committed misdemeanor violations of the CWA. The Company has been in negotiations with the EPA regarding these possible misdemeanor charges and anticipates entering a plea with respect to these alleged violations within the next 60 days. The Company estimates that its liability for settlement of the misdemeanor violations will be approximately \$600,000.
