**Item 3.03. Material Modification to Rights of Security Holders.**

On March 20, 2018, TriState Capital Holdings, Inc. (the Company) issued an aggregate of 1,400,000 depository shares (the Depository Shares), each representing a 1/40<sup>th</sup> ownership interest in a share of 6.75% Fixed-to-Floating Rate Series A Non-Cumulative Perpetual Preferred Stock, no par value (the Series A Preferred Stock), with a liquidation preference of \$1,000 per share of Series A Preferred Stock (equivalent to \$25 per Depository Share), which represents \$35,000,000 in aggregate liquidation preference. The Depository Shares are represented by depository receipts (the Depository Receipts). Under the terms of the Series A Preferred Stock, the ability of the Company to declare or pay any dividends on, make distributions with respect to, or to redeem, purchase or acquire, or make a liquidation payment on its common stock or any preferred stock ranking on a parity with or junior to the Series A Preferred Stock, will be subject to restrictions in the event that the Company does not declare dividends on the Series A Preferred Stock for the most recently completed dividend period. The terms of the Series A Preferred Stock are more fully described in the Articles of Amendment relating thereto, filed on March 16, 2018 with the Secretary of the Commonwealth of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (the Articles of Amendment), which establish the voting and other powers, preferences and relative, participating, optional or other rights, and the qualifications, limitations and restrictions relating to the Series A Preferred Stock. A copy of the Articles of Amendment is included as Exhibit 3.1 to this Current Report on Form 8-K and is incorporated by reference herein.

The terms of the Depository Shares are set forth in the Deposit Agreement, dated March 20, 2018, among the Company, Computershare Inc. and Computershare Trust Company, N.A., and the holders from time to time of the Depository Receipts (the Deposit Agreement) and the form of Depository Receipt. Copies of the Deposit Agreement and the form of Depository Receipt are included as Exhibit 4.1 and Exhibit 4.2, respectively, to this Current Report on Form 8-K and are incorporated by reference herein.

**Item 5.03. Amendments to Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws; Change in Fiscal Year.**

On March 16, 2018, the Company filed the Articles of Amendment with the Secretary of the Commonwealth of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, establishing the voting and other powers, preferences and relative, participating, optional or other rights, and the qualifications, limitations and restrictions of the Series A Preferred Stock. The Articles of Amendment became effective with the Secretary of the Commonwealth of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania upon filing. A copy of the Articles of Amendment is included as Exhibit 3.1 to this Current Report on Form 8-K and is incorporated by reference herein.

**Item 8.01. Other Events.**

On March 20, 2018, the Company completed the issuance and sale of 1,400,000 Depository Shares, each representing a 1/40<sup>th</sup> ownership interest in a share of the Series A Preferred Stock, pursuant to an Underwriting Agreement, dated March 15, 2018, between the Company and Sandler O'Neill & Partners, L.P., as representative of the several underwriters named in Schedule A thereto (the Underwriting Agreement). Pursuant to the Underwriting Agreement, the Company has granted the underwriters a 30-day option to purchase 210,000 additional Depository Shares. The sale of the Depository Shares was made pursuant to the Company's Registration Statement on Form S-3 (File No. 333-222074) (the Registration Statement). The following documents are being filed with this Current Report on Form 8-K and incorporated by reference into the Registration Statement: (i) the Underwriting Agreement, (ii) the Articles of Amendment, (iii) the Deposit Agreement, (iv) the form of Depository Receipt and (v) the legal opinions as to the legality of the Depository Shares and the Series A Preferred Stock.
