## Explanation of Responses:

- (1) The reporting person has been the Appointed Fiduciary of the estate since May 2015. Except to the extent of his pecuniary interest, the reporting person disclaims beneficial ownership of the securities held by the estate.
  - (2) Such options were granted on August 14, 2008 pursuant to the Company's Amended and Restated 1999 Incentive Compensation Plan. Such options were fully vested on August 14, 2012.
  - (3) The restricted stock units were granted on May 22, 2014 under the Cognizant Technology Solutions 2009 Incentive Compensation Plan and vest in equal quarterly installments over 12 quarters beginning on September 1, 2014, so that the stock units will be fully vested on June 1, 2017.
  - (4) Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the Company's Class A Common Stock.

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- The restricted stock units were granted on December 1, 2014 under the Cognizant Technology Solutions 2009 Incentive Compensation Plan and vest in equal quarterly installments over 12 quarters beginning on March 1, 2015, so that the stock units will be fully vested on December 1, 2017.

- Represents the remaining number of performance-based restricted stock units which vested based upon attainment by the Company of certain performance milestones, as determined by the Company's compensation committee on February 25, 2016 based upon the audited financials for the 2015 fiscal year. The performance-based restricted stock units were granted on December 1, 2014 under the Cognizant Technology Solutions 2009 Incentive Compensation Plan. In accordance with the performance-based restricted stock unit award, 50% of the vested performance-based restricted stock units were settled in the Company's Class A Common Stock on June 1, 2016. (Continued in the next footnote.)

- (Continued from the previous footnote.) The remaining 50% of the vested performance-based restricted stock units will be settled in the Company's Class A Common Stock on December 1, 2017, provided that the grantee remains in the Company's service through such anniversary date. Each performance-based restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the Company's Class A Common Stock.
