Item 1.01 Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement.

Three of the Corporation's directors, Richard Anderson, Thomas Anderson and Paul Kraus, have been residing in homes leased from the Corporation pursuant to pre-paid lifetime leaseholds. The Corporation has, effective June 30, 2006, sold each home to its tenant for a purchase price equal to its third party appraised fair market value, net of the fair market value of the tenant's lifetime leasehold interest. The transactions were approved by the independent directors of the Corporation, with the advice of independent real estate advisors, appraisers and counsel.
