ITEM 9. REGULATION FD DISCLOSURE

The VICKSBURG has been awarded a contract by Chevron Offshore (Thailand) Limited ("Chevron") for a drilling program offshore Thailand. The rig will move to the Chevron drilling location immediately upon completing the drilling program on the current platform for ExxonMobil Exploration & Production Malaysia Inc. ("EMEPMI"). The EMEPMI contract for the VICKSBURG will be suspended upon completion of drilling on the current platform which is expected to be around May 15, 2004. The Chevron contract provides for a dayrate of \$66,500. The VICKSBURG will remain on dayrate during the period required to relocate the rig

from Malaysia to Thailand.

Additional information with respect to the Company's Contract Status Summary at March 16, 2004 is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1 which is being furnished in accordance with Rule 101(e)(1) under Regulation FD and should not be deemed to be filed.
