- (1) On October 6, 2008 the Registrant entered into a Product Supply Agreement (PSA) which is an amendment of a September 30, 2003 Contract Manufacturing Agreement with Martin Marietta Magnesia Specialties, LLC (Martin Marietta). Other than in respect of the PSA, there is no material relationship between the Registrant or its affiliates and Martin Marietta.
- (2) The PSA is material to the Registrant in that it provides the Registrant with a stable supply from Martin Marietta of magnesium hydroxide products for the Registrant s requirements in the United States and Canada until December 31, 2013. Magnesium hydroxide products are a significant component of the Registrants FUEL CHEM® programs which assist the Registrant s customers in the reduction of boiler slagging and SQemissions.
